7:00-10:15 PM—"Haunted Forest" Rides (...when the REAL HAUNTING BEGINS!!!)

(9 PM and earlier times will be booked first—when those are filled the later times will be opened up)

- Haunted evening will begin and end at the Divots Conference Center (DeVent parking lot-West 275).
- Arrive 15 minutes before your scheduled departure time.
- Buses will leave on schedule. You will ride the "Haunted Bus" to the Kiwanis Camp where you will board a trolley that will take you through the "Haunted Forest" and the bus will return you to the DeVent Center.
- **NEW this year!** Kids ages 10 & up will have the option of taking a "walking haunted path" during the last part of the ride. You will be picked up at the end of the walking path by the same trolley. Beware....the scare will be much closer!
- Round trip will last about 60 minutes (**Saturday's 5:00-6:45 PM** trips will last longer if you choose to have your children participate in doing crafts at the camp cabin-if you do, you will be dropped off at the cabin and catch a later trolley back out to the bus).

Dress up in your favorite costume so you will fit right in!
